

# DRI-GON

## PATIENT INFORMATION LEAFLET

Information for the Patient about DRI-GON

Read all of this leaflet carefully before you start using DRI-GON, because it contains important information for you.  
This product is available without a doctor's prescription. Nevertheless you still need to use DRI-GON carefully to get the best results from it.

- Keep this leaflet. You may need to read it again.
- If you have further questions, please ask your doctor or pharmacist.
- You must see a doctor if your symptoms worsen or do not improve.

### PROPRIETARY NAME (AND DOSAGE FORM):

DRI-GON (Eye Drops).

### COMPOSITION:

Active Ingredient	Concentration (mg/ml)
*Carboxymethylcellulose sodium	5,0
Preservative: Stabilised Oxychloro Complex	0,05

\* Also known as Carmellose.

Other ingredients include boric acid, calcium chloride dihydrate, hydrochloric acid, magnesium chloride hexahydrate, potassium chloride, sodium chloride, sodium hydroxide, sodium lactate, and water for injection.

### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

DRI-GON is an ophthalmic solution for the relief of dry eye related conditions.

DRI-GON may be used for the temporary relief of ocular burning, irritation, and discomfort associated with dry eyes, or due to exposure to wind, sun or other environmental factors.

DRI-GON may also be used as a protectant against further irritation.

Common causes of dry eyes include computer use, smoking, prolonged contact lens use, certain medications, and aging.

### BEFORE YOU USE DRI-GON:

Do NOT use DRI-GON:

- If you are allergic (hypersensitive) to any of the ingredients in the formulation.
- If you are pregnant or breastfeeding your baby (see "Pregnancy and breastfeeding").
- DRI-GON should not be used to replace any medicines prescribed by your doctor.

### Pregnancy and breastfeeding:

Do NOT use DRI-GON while you are pregnant or breastfeeding your baby as safety has not been established. DRI-GON may only be used if you are pregnant or breastfeeding your baby after your doctor has evaluated all the risks and still feels that the benefits outweigh the risks.

### WARNINGS:

The use of DRI-GON by more than one person may spread infections.

Do not use if the tamper-evident seal is broken.

**FOR EXTERNAL USE ONLY. NOT FOR INJECTION.**

Consult your doctor if you experience eye pain, changes in vision, continued redness, or irritation of the eye.

Discontinue the use of DRI-GON if symptoms worsen or persist for more than 72 hours, and consult your doctor or healthcare professional.

Do not use if the solution's colour changes or becomes cloudy.

### RECOMMENDED USE:

Instil one to two drops into the affected eye(s) as needed or as directed by a healthcare professional.

Do not use more than 30 days after opening.

### DRUG INTERACTIONS:

None known.

### POSSIBLE SIDE-EFFECTS:

DRI-GON may have side-effects.

Should your general health worsen while using DRI-GON, please consult your doctor, pharmacist or other healthcare professional for advice.

DRI-GON is well tolerated, but occasionally stinging, burning, red eyes, or allergic reactions can occur after use.

### STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS:

Store at or below 25 °C.

Protect from sunlight. Do not freeze.

Keep container tightly closed.

Use this solution within one month (30 days) after opening.

Do not dispose in drains or sewerage systems (e.g. toilets).

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.**

### IDENTIFICATION OF DRI-GON:

A clear, colourless solution.

### PRESENTATION OF DRI-GON:

10 ml or 15 ml sterile solution contained in a green plastic bottle, with a green plastic dispensing nozzle and plastic cap, packed in an outer carton.

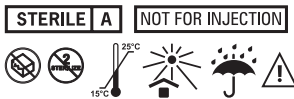
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
